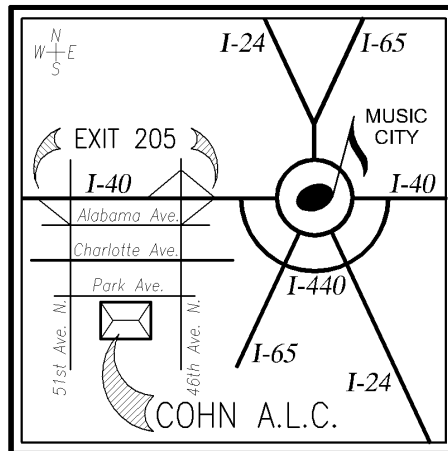

## 🌀 PERFORMERS

**JOANNA REINER** is an English and Scottish Dancer and leader in the Philadelphia area. Her calling has taken her across the country, from Amherst to Ann Arbor, from Neffa to Heydaze, including several sessions at Pinewoods Camp in Plymouth, MA. Joanna is an avid dance gypsy, and in her spare time, works to support her dance habit.

**CHRISSEY DAVIS-CAMP** grew up dancing in the mountains of East Tennessee. In great demand as a caller for English Country Dance, Contra Dance, and Community Dance for all ages, she has called dances for 26 years from Boston to Tampa, from Bloomington to Salem, and numerous points in between.

**BARE NECESSITIES** is a Boston-based quartet known nationwide for its unique presentation of English country dance music. The quartet has been playing weekly country dances since 1978. In the course of their concertizing and dance playing, they have developed an extraordinarily inventive and playful sound with its interweaving of harmonies and counter melodies.

**PETER BARNES** is a professional folk musician for over 25 years and publisher of music tune and instruction books. Peter plays the piano, flute and assorted other instruments for traditional dancing. He has been invited to most major contra, square, British Isles and vintage dance events throughout the United States. Averaging over 250 engagements per year since 1980, Peter is arguably one of Boston's busiest musicians.

**EARL GADDIS** has been fiddling for a mixture of English, Scottish, American and international dancing for more than 30 years. After years of a very full, varied and interesting work life, Earl is now a full-time professional musician, playing violin and viola for dance events throughout the country.

**MARY LEA** is classically trained and from a musical family. Mary has been playing dance music professionally since 1977. A year later, she joined two Boston-based bands, Yankee Ingenuity, playing New England contra music and the other, Bare Necessities, performing English country dance music. Mary has been a member of these groups ever since.

**JACQUELINE SCHWAB**, a folk and classical improvisational pianist who plays "gorgeously spare piano" (The Boston Globe) yet "sounds as if she has an orchestra at her fingertips" (Sing Out). Jacqueline was chosen by the renowned Ken Burns for numerous public television documentaries due to the emotional expression in her playing. And, she performed at the White House for President Clinton in 1997 and also at the Smithsonian in 2000.
